

All Male Cake Bake Rules - 2006

1. Cakes must be baked by the Cub Scout and a male partner (Dad, grandpa, friend). No moms or ladies in the kitchen.
2. Cub Scouts must help clean up, too.
3. Cake mixes may be used.
4. The entire cake must be edible - including all decorations. (Hint: you may use celery, carrots anything edible for trees, canoes, etc...)
5. All cakes must have a theme - scouting related is suggested. Themes for 2006 are: Music, Magic, Scouting, Patriotic.
6. All cakes must be checked in and registered at the banquet, no later than 6:15 p.m. Cakes arriving later may be used for dessert but will not be included in the judging.
7. All cakes must be on a "Give - Away" tray or board. We cannot be responsible for plates or serving trays.
8. The name of the scout who made the cake should NOT appear anywhere on the cake. Numbers will be assigned for judging purposes.
9. Cakes will be judged at the banquet. Cakes are judged on appearance, decorations, creativity, and originality.
10. Awards of 1st, 2nd, 3rd in each theme listed above will be given.
